SECURITY BADGE PROCEDURES

As of last year, the Eisemann Center implemented security measures for ANYONE who will enter the backstage area—and that applies to every competitor! We need your help so that this extra step doesn't interfere with you being your very best onstage.

1. GET YOUR SECURITY BADGE: As soon as you arrive onsite, visit the Eisemann Center to get your Security Badge. (Yes, you will have an All-Events Ticket + two tickets to get into the house at the EC + a backstage Security Badge!) Definitely get yours **at the latest the day before** you need to spend any time backstage or onstage at the EC.

To get to the Security Badge Desk, walk all the way through the garage to the back side of the theater (Performance Drive), turn right and enter in the North Backstage Door. (It will be marked.) The desk will be open:

2. HAVE YOUR SECURITY BADGE VISIBLE: You MUST show your badge to the security staff anytime you are coming backstage/going onstage throughout the weekend—including the briefings, mic testing and competing!

When you're in the contest pattern, as you leave the Renaissance, have your Security Badge out and ready to show! That way, your quartet or chorus can breeze by the security desk, flash your badge, get lined up—and THEN put your badge away in your assigned pattern bags or hidden under your costume. **Don't hold up the pattern because you don't have yours visible!**

Can a friend pick mine up? No. Every person must appear in person at the EC Security Badge Desk to get their own badge.

I have my AET. Isn't that enough? No. The EC does not recognize the Region 25 AET as an official security badge.

Do I need a Security Badge to get into the audience chamber? No. You only need your AET and ticket to get into the audience. However, if you any duties backstage or onstage or you are a competitor in the pattern, you must have your Security Badge ready to show.
